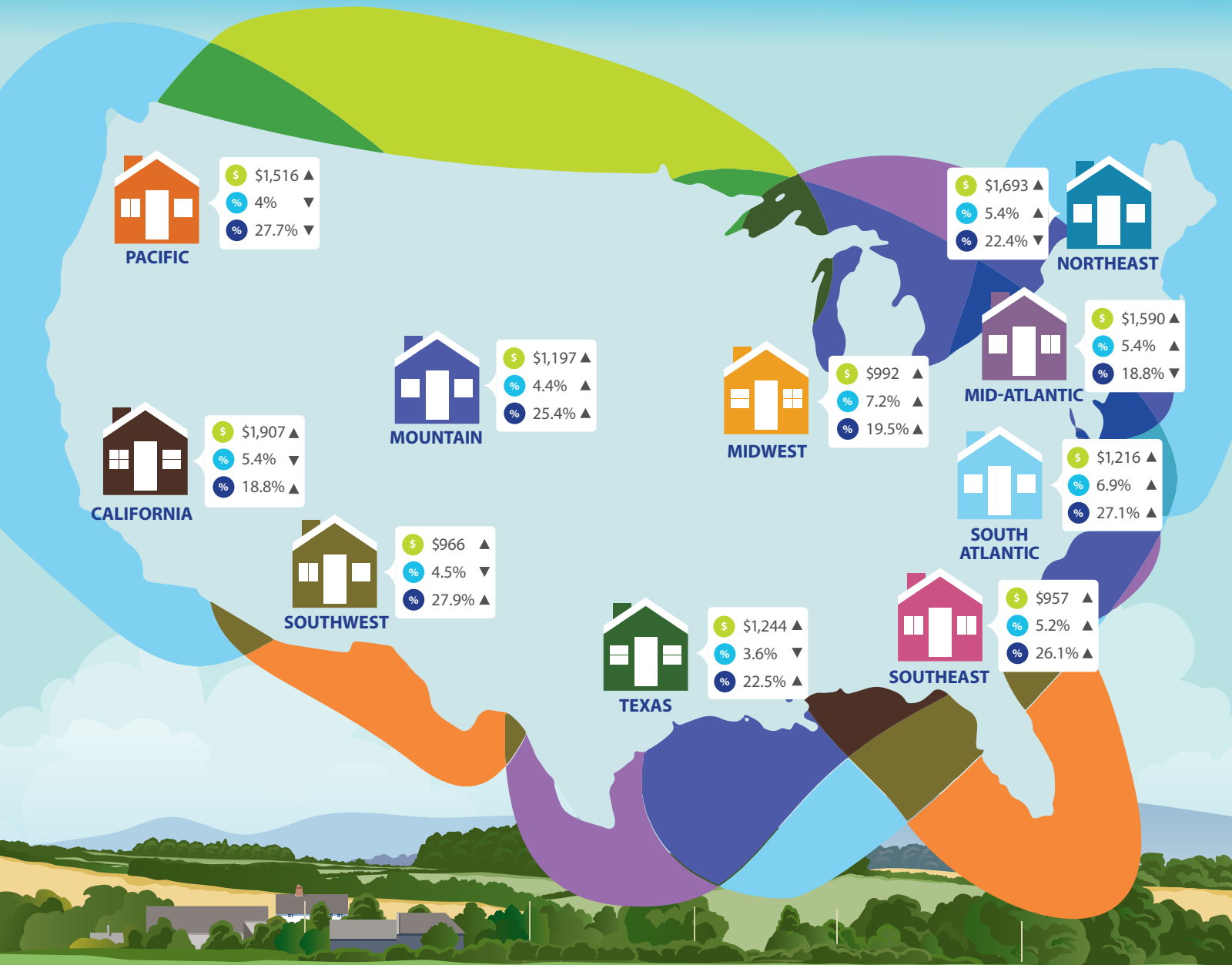


# RENTAL HOUSING STATISTICS

## 1st Quarter 2015



### National Highlights:

- Rental rates are up in all 10 regions, with the largest increases in the Pacific and Northeast regions.
- The national vacancy rate rose slightly to 5.7% - the Midwest has the highest vacancy rate and Texas the lowest
- Nationally, 23.4% of single-family homes are rented

### Regional Statistics:



**Rental Rate** – The median rental rate for 3 bedroom homes rented during March 2015



**Vacancy Rate** – The average percent of homes considered unoccupied as of March 31, 2015



**Saturation Rate** – The estimated percentage of rented single-family homes as a share of all single family homes as of January 2015
